The following issues were discussed.

1. Proposed Local Law # 4 of the Year 2018 to be renamed Proposed Local Law # 1 of the Year 2019 – Street Openings.
2. The group discussed the draft of a proposed local law to amend Chapter 184 of the Code of the Village of Bellerose (BVC) – to provide greater protection and enforcement regarding repair and restoration of streets and surface openings. Also, to amend to provide greater enforcement of safety precautions for excavations.
3. Openings and excavations.
4. Permits, deposits, fees, performance bonds or cash assurances and defaults actions.
5. Restorations or replacements of surfaces after openings.
6. Protected street concept of five (5) years protection for no reopening after the completion of a street improvement unless an emergency.
7. Construction specifications for backfills for temporary and permanent situations. Includes affected streets, highways, sidewalks, curbs, driveway aprons, gutters, catch basins, trees, or other work deemed in disrepair or unsatisfactory by the Village.
8. Building Inspector and Engineer level oversight and approvals.
9. Updating antiquated code for safety precautions fines for excavations.
10. R. Belziti advised the Board that he sent notification letters to all utilities regarding the Road Project specifically noting the reconstruction of Hudson and Ontario Roads west of Commonwealth Boulevard planned for Spring/Summer 2019.
11. A discussion ensued on notification to residents whose roads were being repaved and residents village-wide.
12. R. Handler reviewed the proposed amendments with the Board and agreed to revise Proposed Local Law # 1 of the Year 2019 within five (5) days and forward it to the Board.
13. R. Shea advised that all legal and public notices were published for the Public Hearing.
14. The members of the Board of Trustees concurred that the purpose of the Local Law # 1 of the Year 2019 was to provide the best protection for the residents/taxpayers of the Village in relation to the investment and execution of the Capital Road Improvement Project.

On motion by Mayor Schreiber, and seconded by Deputy Mayor Juliano, and carried, the meeting adjourned at 9:15PM.
